

CROWNS OF CREATION MINISTRIES - HOW WE SERVE

List of areas we have served the kingdom of God with our time, treasures, and talents since our establishment in 2010. In the cases of helping an individual we have preserved their anonymity.

1. Replenish Outdoor Food Pantry weekly to bring food and hygiene supplies to our areas' homeless and hungry.
2. Provide shelter items such as a tent, etc to protect our homeless population.
3. Nassau County Humane Society 'no-kill' shelter.
4. Cats Angels Hospital Care facility which helps take care of the cat population via free services to homeless/abused/feral animals.
5. Donations to Pastors Discretionary Fund (Memorial United Methodist Church) which allows Pastors to reach the needy people who fall between the cracks of eligibility for services.
6. Medical Supplies for the suffering people of Ukraine.
7. Nassau County Sober Living which gives recovering alcoholics, shelter and a new start.
8. Provide money for yearly Teachers School Supplies which are not covered by the education system.
9. Various Disaster relief donations (hygiene kits, clean-up supplies) via Methodist Church UMCOR. i.e. Texas floods
10. NAMI – National Association of Mental Illness who provide help and resources for individuals and families treating mental illnesses.
11. Our local Council On Aging – a not-for-profit organization addressing the needs of our aging population.
12. Individuals (unnamed) in our sphere of influence who have temporarily fallen upon hard times. We pay for their food, electric bills, rent, and sometimes provide (more dignified) clothing to help them get back on their feet again.
13. Distribute \$15 Gift Cards to people we encounter during our day who look like they could use it - (Neighborhood Ministry). Sometimes it's a mom who arrives at the grocery checkout line and realizes she has to put items back because she can't afford them.
14. "Movember" Movement which helps men with mental illnesses.
15. Barnabas Center which supplies services for the poor and needy.
16. Innocence Project – non profit using advanced DNA to free innocent individuals who have been wrongfully convicted.
17. ARK Wildlife Rescue – rehabilitation for injured, ill, or orphaned wildlife.
